EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Happy Hamfest and my special day of course "Valentine's Day".

February is the usual month for an "ice storm" or two (2) so start making your preparations now. Go to www.ready.gov and look for "winter survival tips" and also look under "Loss of power" hints too. Learn from other people's mistakes as well as your own. Loss of power can happen all during this winter. Also remember when the Ravenel Bridge had to be shutdown twice, first because of icy roads then days later as ice fell off of the cable stays. Routes can be impacted by ice easily.

I have not received much input about having a Low Country ARES group meeting but I suggest a late May or June meeting to update groups on Hurricane season and preparations for the up coming season. Remember with the Govenor's office controlling county evacuations coordination is going to be absolutely essential. Out going traffic routes and returning traffic routes need to be learned again and alternates planned. Hurricane Matthew opened the eyes of many new residents about the power of a hurricane and just how disrupting they can be.

Along with lessons learned because of Hurricane Matthew, the Red Cross and County Emergency Management is now asking for Ham Radio Operators be assigned to the few shelters to be established pre storm and to shelters for returning residents so I most definitely NEED volunteers for these shelters.
