EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Welcome to Hurricane season 2017. There are many things to consider and to prepare for the season. Expect the Skywarn net to be conducted every Tuesday at 2100 local and this will run from June 1, 2017 until 30 November 2017. Look at several sources for information. The local newspaper had the 2017 Hurricane Guide, NOAA site, Ready.gov site, and your own home owners insurance companies have resources and guides with good ideas and tips for this season. Also now is the time to check out your exit route if evacuating. There is construction on many routes like 41 and the I-26 reversal worked during Hurricane Matthew so expect it to be used again.

Starting in June, the Sunday evening Low Country ARES net will start on W4KSD's Hurricane Preps on a budget so everyone will be prepared by mid August when hurricanes strike the Low Country.

On June 7, 2017 the South Carolina Emergency Management Division and Charleston County EMD will be conducting the annual Full Scale Exercise with the event being a Hurricane. Expect a net for either Skywarn or ARES or both on that day. Please participate as it is good practice and demonstrates Amateur Radio's abilities and the contribution to the area that hams make every day.

As Charleston County Emergency Coordinator, I have been asked to help set up radio stations at various Fire Stations around the county and at shelters so there will be a need for several teams of communicators as back up to conventional methods during a real emergency and the recovery. So expect a request for support from me.

We currently have a station in the Low Country Fire fighter support station where we keep the CARS Communications trailer and now at the St. Paul's station #1 and in the Isle of Palms fire station so in an emergency there is back up communications in these locations. Next on the schedule is Awendaw Fire Station, stay tuned for more.

Speaking of the Communications trailer, there is now a working 2 meter repeater installed. The frequency is 145.250, down 600Hz, Tone 123.0. The tone will in the future be selectable and most probably off.

Repeater Report: Bryce, K4LXF

The 441.575 repeater is still not linking up with the state wide system.

Bryce gave a talk asking people to wait to see if someone wants a radio check or if they are just checking their radio. Bryce also explained a few of the repeater controller functions: If you press the DTMF keys in a sequence, you can get feedback from the controller.

Key your mic and identify yourself and then press the number 3 twice (33) and un-key. The repeater should come back with the date and time.

Key your mic and identify yourself and then press the number 4 twice (44) and un-key. The repeater should come back and say something like "ready to record". Key your mic and say a sentence or two and un-key. The repeater should repeat your messages back to you and you should hear what you really sound like.

Key your mic and identify yourself and then press the number 5 twice (55) and un-key. Now when you press any DTMF key(s) the repeater will tell you what keys you pressed.

This information only goes through the repeater you are tuned to, not over the linked system.
