#### **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS**

Now that Hurricane season is here and we have had 3 named storms already --- NOW is the time to start checking your emergency kits, evacuation routes and vehicle status. Also, the Red Cross and Charleston County Emergency Management Division has requested Ham Radio support at the shelters. I am compiling the list of shelters and would like folks who live nearby the shelter and are not planning to evacuate, to volunteer if possible to support these shelters. The approved shelters for Charleston County are:

North Charleston High School, 1087 E. Montague Ave.

Stall High School, 3625 Ashley Phosphate Rd.

A.C. Corcoran Elementary, 8585 Vista Rd.

Midland Park Primary, 2415 Midland Park Rd.

Ladson Elementary, 3321 Ladson Rd.

Edmund A Burns Elementary, 3795 Spruill Ave. (pet/pet owner shelter)

These are pre – event shelters, there will be more post event shelters requiring Amateur support for post event shelters and relay stations. Hope everyone enjoyed "Field Day". A great learning process for disaster and public service events where weather and the elements affect operations and conditions. This is always a good experience and fun experience. Speaking of planned public service events and weather conditions. This year on August 21, 2017 there will be a solar eclipse over the Charleston County area. City of Charleston has asked the County Emergency Management Division to activate the County EOC. Because of this request the Charleston County EMD is considering a partial activation for this event. The times considered are from 0900 to 2100 on August 21,2017. If they activate, I will man the EOC radio room and do a roll call for ARES at approx. 0930 and then at approx. 1400 since the event should occur between 1400 and 1500. I do NOT expect any problems but I will ask you to have a radio nearby and support this activation. The reason the City of Charleston asked is, as of June 12, 2017, over 85% of hotel space is already booked and 66% of county space is booked. Also have been informed that the Columbia area is filling fast. So it is a precaution only.

Remember again, the lane reversal of I-26 and using I-526 to go from Mt. Pleasant to West Ashley or from West Ashley to Mt. Pleasant WILL force you onto I-26 and send you to Columbia. Consider this when travelling during an emergency situation.
