#### **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS**

Get ready for Spring. Now is the time to prepare for the surprise severe weather events. The Upstate is preparing for Severe Thunderstorms and Tornadoes. The Low Country does get severe thunderstorms, but tornadoes are rare events. Check out the local Weather Service website for training and preparations available and keep a weather eye during these volatile months ahead.

Waiting for the Hurricane predictions which should be coming out soon and be aware the National Hurricane Center is looking for net control operators for the up coming season, check it out and help if possible. Start your planning like evacuation supplies, evacuation routes (have more than one), and have recommended documents organized. The Low Country has been lucky so far but stay prepared anyway. A Hurricane Helene is always a possibility in the coastal region of South Carolina.

There will be NO Charleston County ARES meeting in March.

Try learning a digital mode like Winlink. Emergency Management Departments are trying to use this mode. A radio is NOT required to use the application, use "Telnet" which is the internet. Yes, the internet could fail during an event but knowing the app will help you with a radio or operate from another station as an alternate operator. There are ARES members with experience and willing to help you learn and you can go to "Wavetalkers" website for videos too. Check into the SCWinlinkTuesday net for experience.

With the better weather there will be the annual Full-Scale Exercises that the State and Counties have to perform for certifications. Listen closely to radio traffic on the repeaters, all exercise traffic should say "This is an exercise or drill" listen for the whole message and don't jump to a conclusion about a training exercise.

There will be outdoor events soon for disaster information. Try and make some, you can help demonstrate Amateur Radio and pick up latest information about other services available.
